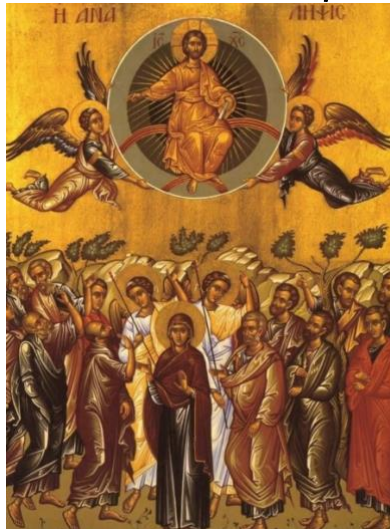




160 Years of Ministry
