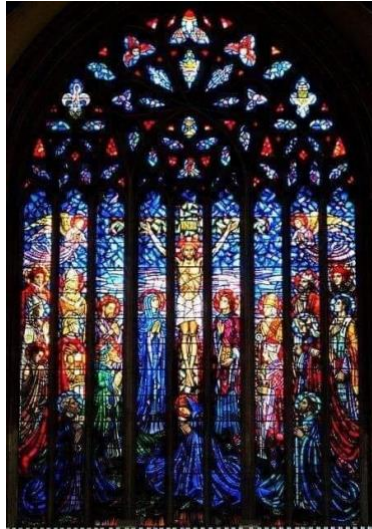




160 Years of Ministry

The Londonderry Air is a traditional Irish folk melody that was collected by Jane Ross in Limavady in 1851. She heard a traveling musician play it on the street and wrote down the notes. The tune, which had no name but was believed to originate from County Londonderry, was published in 1855 and later became the melody for the famous song "Danny Boy".
