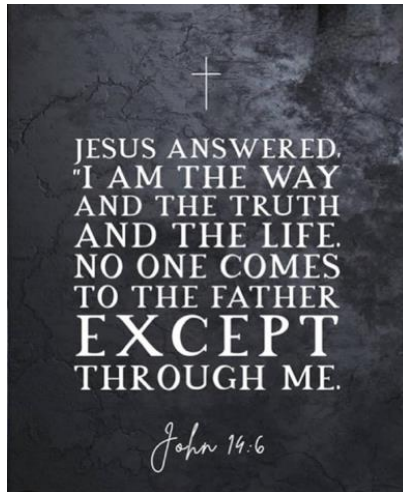




Christ Church, Belleville, with St. Paul's, Roslin

Postlude: The New Commonwealth R. Vaughn Williams (1972-1958)

R. Vaughn Williams was born in the village of Down Ampney, Gloucestershire, England. He was a violinist, organist, and composer. His composition teacher was the great C.H. Parry who wrote the famous melody, "Jerusalem". His works include: operas, ballets, religious and secular vocal pieces, and several works for orchestra, including nine symphonies.
