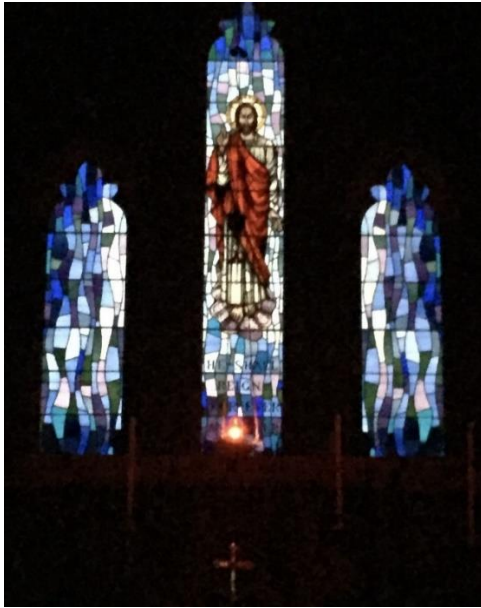




Christ Church, Belleville, with St. Paul's, Roslin

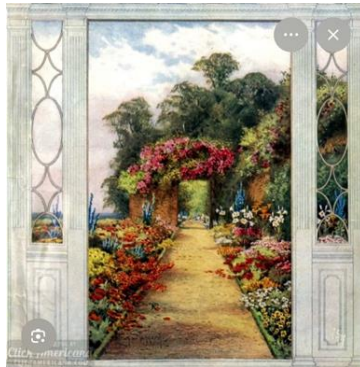

Musical Notes

Prelude: Nun Danket Alle Gott (Now thank we all our God) J.S. Bach
(1685-1750)

This famous hymn, written in 1636 by German pastor Martin Rinkart, consists of three main verses focusing on thanksgiving, divine guidance, and praise to the Trinity. Here, J.S. Bach has arranged it for organ with the melody ringing out by use of an organ reed stop, in this case the trumpet solo.
