Varied concert for Carpe Diem

A near capacity crowd jammed into the Parrott Gallery on June 6 to enjoy the annual spring concert by the Carpe Diem ensemble, based at Marmora, but conducted by Belleville area musician-teacher Joel Bootsma.

Repertoire for the 17-piece ensemble spanned baroque era works by Bach to contemporary pieces such as I Have a Dream by ABBA.

Bach works included a movement from his famous Brandenburg Concerto No. 3.

In a more contemporary mood was

Leroy Anderson's Syncopated Clock, Mancini's Pink Panther theme, Georgia on My Mind, by Hoagy Carmichael, Ashokan Farewell by Jay Unger, used as theme music for the American Civil War series, The Lion Sleeps Tonight, and Gabriel's Oboe.

The concert drew generous applause throughout for an ensemble that continues to grow in repertoire and quality year by year.

Following the concert, the musicians adjourned to an adjoining gallery for a group photo. While it is based at Marmora, there are several players from Belleville and area involved.
