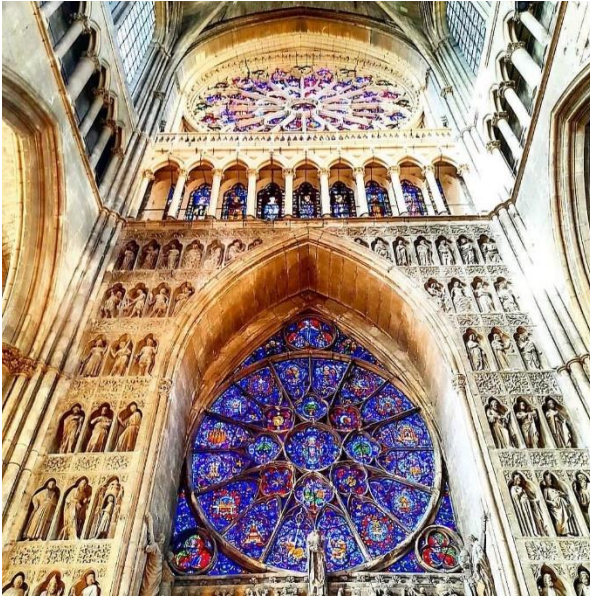


Christ Church, Belleville, with St. Paul's, Roslin
