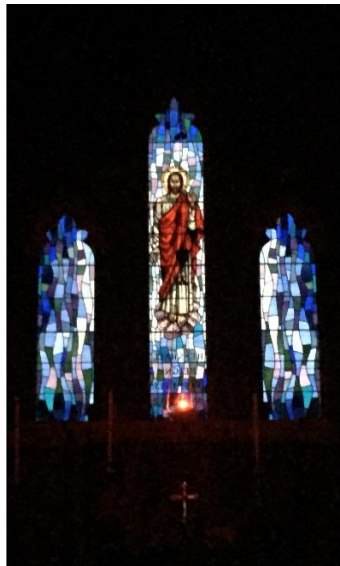




Christ Church, Belleville, with St. Paul's, Roslin

Musical Notes

Prelude: Jesu, Joy of Man's Desiring J.S. Bach (1685 -1750)

Communion: Hymn 531: You Who Dwell in the Shelter

Postlude: : Hymn to Joy L. Beethoven (1770- 1827) Lyrics by Henry van Dyke (1852-1933)

Henry van Dyke was a well-established professor of English literature at Princeton University when he visited the president of William College in Western Massachusetts one day in 1907. There, he was overwhelmed by the beauty of the Berkshires. He picked up his pen and wrote the words of the hymn, 'Joyful, Joyful, we Adore Thee.' Upon handing the poem to his friend, van Dyke said, 'Here is a hymn for you. Your mountains were my inspiration. It must be sung to the music of Beethoven's 'Hymn to Joy.'"
